### ***Fishmeal / Rendering Plant Technician:***

We are looking for a candidate experienced with Fishmeal plant machinery operators (any of the following raw material converters:

- Atlas-Stord Plant
- Stord International
- Alfa Laval Thermal

Or similar product conversion machinery consisting of:

- Cooker
- Press
- Dryer
- Decanting of liquid substances

### ***Duties and Responsibilities:***

- Conducts regular checks on fishmeal production, inspects the product, assures it is in accordance with ASC product specifications
- Inspects and records criteria such as temperature, moisture, weight, packaging condition and labeling as per ASC product specifications
- Instructs and motivates the Processing team under his/her supervision. Reports any problems with personnel to Factory Manager or Foremen for disciplinary action as needed
- Maintains vessel HACCP Plan and Sanitation Plan as per State and Federal Regulatory Requirements
- Ensures Factory conformance with Food Safety Standards and Good Manufacturing Practices
- Prepares and submits product samples as requested by Factory Manager or Quality Control Manager as necessary
- Completes tallying duties at off-load to ensure accurate accounting of discharged product
- Assure the Fishmeal Plant is properly maintained

Minimum of 3 years vessel experience is preferred.

### ***Physical Ability:***

The candidate for the Electrician position must meet general company standards regarding physical condition, hearing and eyesight minimums. The candidate must have the ability to pass pre-employment and on-going random drug tests. The candidate must also be capable of boarding and exiting a vessel without physical assistance by climbing up and down a gang plank or using a Jacob's ladder. Must climb or descend one or more set of steep stairs or vertical ladders inside and outside the vessel in all weather conditions as extreme as 30 degrees below zero. *All final candidates must submit to a criminal background check.*

### ***Work Schedule:***

- 12 hours or more per day for the duration of the trip, including loading and unloading.
- Ability to work at sea for extended periods of time.
