The Assistant Engineer is responsible for assisting in the manning and other USCG operating regulations for the vessel and the safe and efficient preventative maintenance programs and operation of all ship's engineering systems and processes which would include:

- Fuel and lubrication systems
- Refrigeration plant
- Sewage treatment
- Watermaking/desalinization system

Minimum of 3 years vessel experience is preferred.

Physical Ability:

The candidate for the Assistant Engineer position must meet USCG licensing standards regarding physical condition, hearing and eyesight minimums. The candidate must have the ability to pass pre-employment and on-going random drug tests. The candidate must also be capable of boarding and exiting a vessel without physical assistance by climbing up and down a gang plank or using a Jacob's ladder. Must climb or descend one or more set of steep stairs or vertical ladders inside and outside the vessel in all weather conditions as extreme as 30 degrees below zero. *All final candidates must submit to a criminal background check.*

Work Schedule:

- 12 hours or more per day for the duration of the trip, including loading and unloading.
- Ability to work at sea for extended periods of time.
